

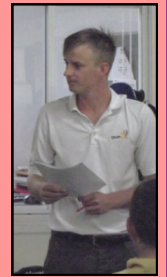


19TH HOLE

Pro Tip - Conforming Golf Clubs.

Have you recently bought some golf clubs either on line or second hand? Was the price too good to be true? Did you know that these golf clubs could either be an imitation or non-conforming for club competitions? The Rules of Golf specify the equipment which may be used to play the game. These specifications can be found in Rule 4 and Appendix II for golf clubs and Rule 5 and Appendix III for golf balls. In general, they are 'descriptive' and 'restrictive' in nature - defining what a golf club should look like and how far a golf ball can travel.

The R&A with the USGA have a detailed description of all clubs and balls that are legal for club competitions. As ALL golf clubs MUST be R&A and USGA approved. If your club is an imitation or knock off then it has not passed these governing bodies approval and is illegal to use in all competitions. These imitations look and feel like the real thing however have not passed the strict R&A and USGA specifications and will be missing serial numbers.

To find out if your driver or irons are legal you can either go to the R & A website www.randa.org and click on the equipment search section, or ask the boys in the pro shop.

The Equipment Search function allows you to search for any club by equipment type, manufacturer, model and specification. There are over 11,000 clubs in the database, so you should be able to locate yours to find out whether it conforms to the Rules of Golf. The Pro Shop will be checking all clubs over the next few months so it would be a good idea to check yours before hand to save any embarrassment.
