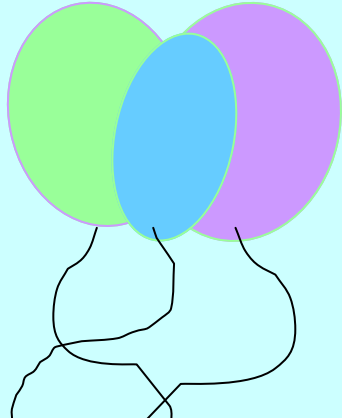
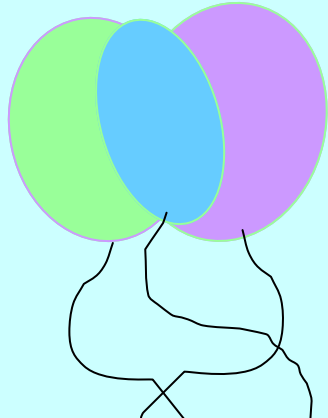

Lynn Gillan was not only the ladies A Grade winner, she and **Mal Shorter** also won the Mixed Foursomes of the year.

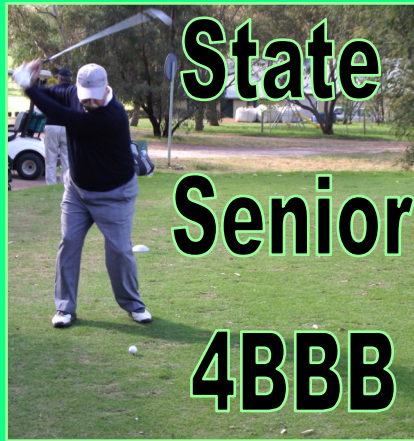
Plenty more awards went out on the night and then party really started!

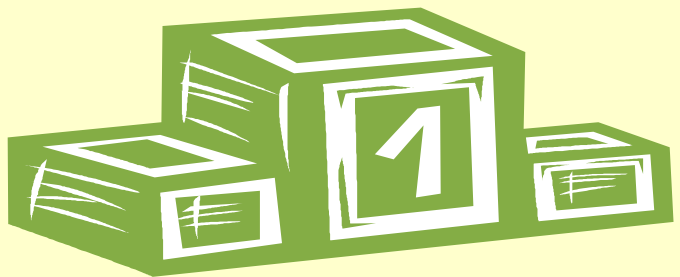

PRO TIP

Lining up Putts

To line your putt up correctly is very important to making more putts and being an overall consistent putter. To do this here are a couple of simple tips;
Mark the ball with a short line and then place it carefully so that line points along the intended line of aim. Many, if not most professionals do this.

As an alternative to the line on the ball, pick a blade of grass about 6 inches ahead of the ball to aim at as an intermediate target. Some find this an easier target at which to aim than the hole, because the blade of grass is in ones peripheral vision while the hole is not. Once you have done this and your ready to fire your putt you might feel a bit odd or uncomfortable but this will come from previous incorrect technique or alignment. Overcoming this feeling and trusting your aim will help you to feel more solid and hopefully hole more putts.
