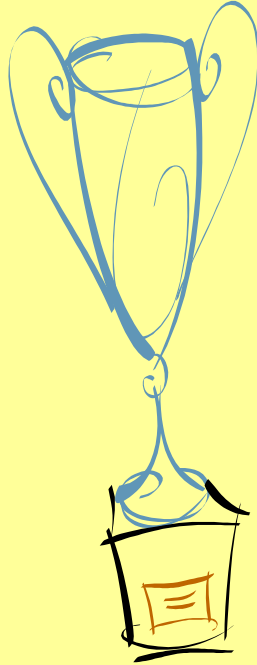

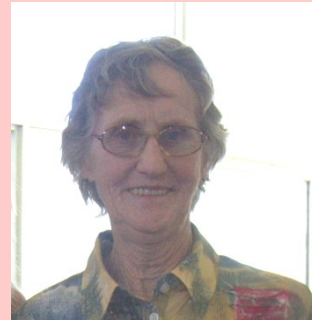

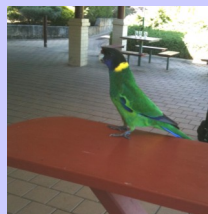
Half yearly fees are due on the 1st October. If you have had a change of address please inform the office staff as invoices will be posted out.

FAIRWAY BUNKER SHOTS

With the introduction of a new fairway bunker on 15 coming soon here are a few tips to help out. When setting up to hit a fairway bunker shot, there are a few things to keep in mind.. Firstly, take more club than you normally would to compensate for lost distance, generally two clubs. For instance, if you usually hit an eight iron 130 metres on the fairway, hit a six iron out of a fairway bunker. Make sure to grip down a little on the club as well. Secondly, dig your shoes into the sand to maintain balance.

Thirdly, to help the ball get into the air more have a stance that is slightly open, aiming about three metres left of your intended target. Also consider opening up the clubface a little. Fourth, as far as ball positioning is concerned, you want to have the ball further back in your stance than usual; just inside the right foot is the ideal position. However, if you are hitting a longer fairway bunker shot, say 170 metres, keep the ball positioned in the middle of the stance. I recommend keeping the ball toward the back of the stance in order to hit a more cleaner shot. Finally, your weight should favour the left side more than the right side.

The Execution

The most important tip to remember is that a fairway bunker shot is not the same as a greenside bunker shot.

With a greenside bunker shot, you are trying to hit an inch behind the ball and have it land softly on the green. With a fairway bunker shot, you want to hit the ball before the sand. In order to do this, you first need to have the ball in the back of the stance. By putting it there, you can take a normal swing and not have to worry about trying to sweep the sand at all. Second, keep the lower body as still as possible throughout the whole swing. If you move it too much, it will almost always lead to the shot being hit fat. Lastly, follow through on the shot and keep a high finish to get the ball out of the fairway bunker.

Good luck and well done to the green staff the 15th Hole looks great.
